

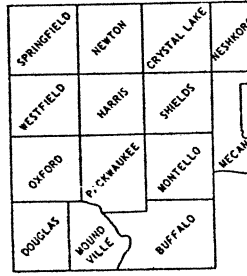

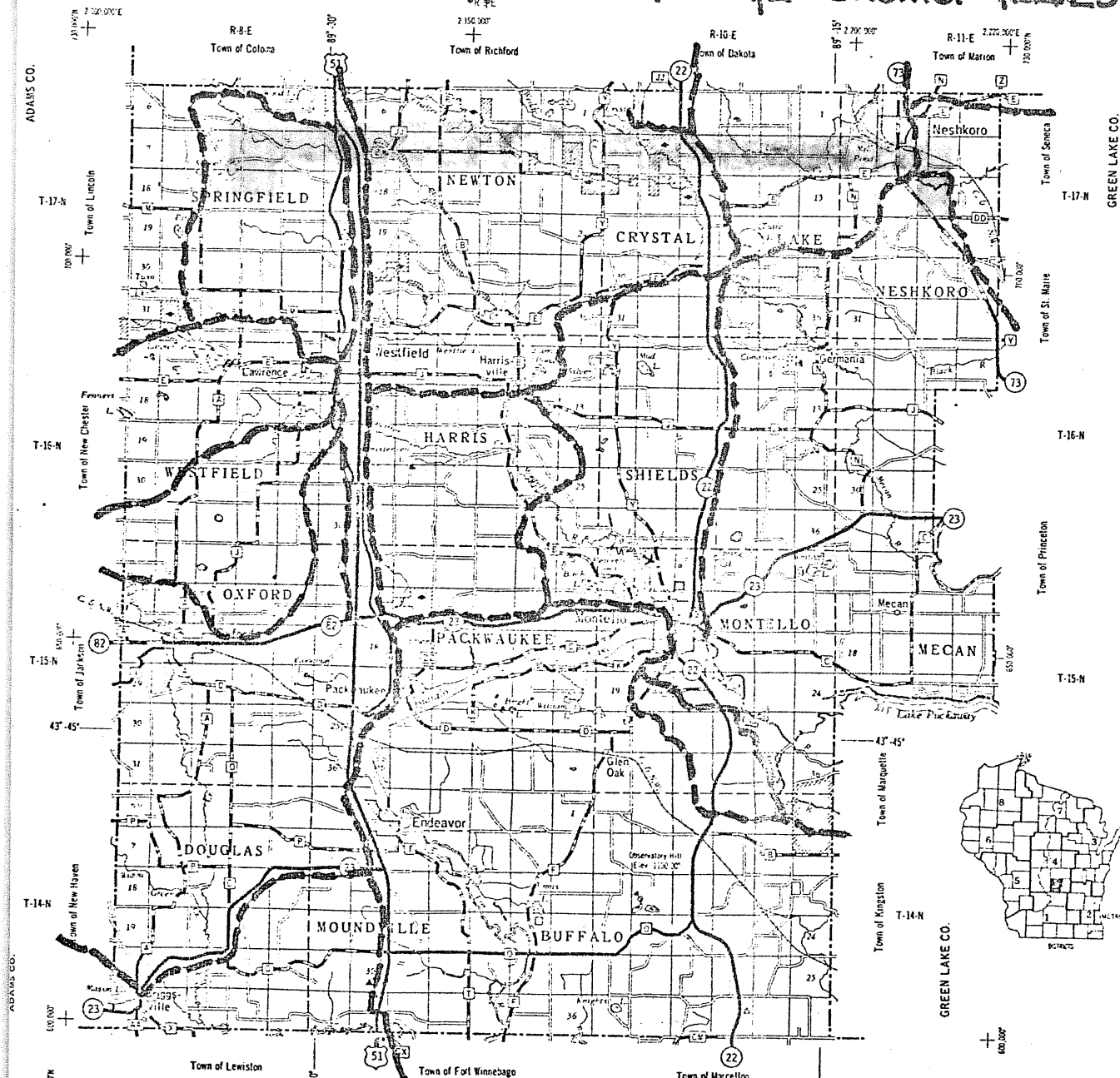

**NOTICE OF SNOWMOBILE
ORDINANCE CHANGE**

**ADDENDUM TO
SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE
72-7 (1)**

The Common Council of the City of Montello, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

(1) City of Montello Snowmobile Routes and Trails.

(a) The following description designates the snowmobile routes and trails within the City of Montello and shall be marked in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes.

1. Trail shall run on Flaherty's Montello Resort and Motel driveway at 465 Underwood SW to Hwy. 23W; thence W across CTH "B" and W along the N side of Hwy. 23W.

2. There shall be two marked crossing points on Hwy. 23W.

A. There shall be a N/S crossing on Hwy. 23W W of CTH "B".

B. There shall be a N/S crossing E of Flaherty's driveway.

3. Trail shall run on the S side of Hwy 23W from the E crossing point W along Hwy. 23W.

4. Trail shall run on the S of Hwy. 23 (w) to the Flaherty driveway; and then run along the edge of Hwy. 23 (w) in an easterly direction to Ellis St. Trail will then run on the W side of Ellis St. to the Marquette County Shop and then crossover to the E side of Ellis St. to either side of Clark St.; in an easterly direction to Stevens St.

A. From Clark Street in a northerly direction on either side of Stevens to Central Avenue.

B. From Stevens in an easterly direction on either side of Central to Underwood Avenue.

5. Trail shall run from Central Avenue S to Kozy Rest Motel property, 106 Central Avenue to the W of and along Underwood Avenue to Shake-N-Burger property.

6. Trail shall run S from Shake-N-Burger property across Lake Street; thence W along the N side of the Montello Municipal Building at Lake/Underwood Avenue into the W area of the

Field; thence in a northerly direction.

D. Trail shall run N/S; in a northerly direction W of Forest Lane School to Forest Lane; thence in an easterly direction.

E. Trail shall run E/W; in an easterly direction on either side of the street on Forest Lane to the Montello Bowbenders property; thence in a northerly direction.

13. All other previously established snowmobile routes and trails within the City of Montello shall be closed.

(b) The Chief of Police is directed and authorized to procure, erect and maintain appropriate snowmobile route, trail and limit signs and markers as approved by the State Department of Natural Resources under s. 350.13, Wis. Stats.

1. The Montello Yetis Snowmobile Club shall be responsible for marking and maintaining designated routes and trails which have been approved by the Common Council and within the City of Montello in accordance with Wis. Stats.

(c) Snowmobile routes and trails within the City of Montello are subject to change as deemed necessary and upon approval by the Common Council of the City of Montello.

(d) No person shall fail to obey any route or trail sign, marker or limit erected in accordance with this ordinance.

(2) Additional Regulations.

(a) Speed. No person shall operate a snowmobile at a rate of speed exceeding 10 miles per hour within the City of Montello.

(b) Hours of Operation. No person shall operate a snowmobile within the City of Montello between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday or between 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Sunday through Friday.

(c) Snowmobile parking will be prohibited in the Parking Lot on the South side of the Municipal Building. Snowmobiles will be allowed to park in the area of the Montello Marina on the north side of the building. The parking area will be posted by signs

to the E side of Ellis St. in an easterly direction to Stevens St.

A. From Clark Street in a northerly direction on either side of Stevens to Central Avenue.

B. From Stevens in an easterly direction on either side of Central to Underwood Avenue.

5. Trail shall run from Central Avenue S to Kozy Rest Motel property, 106 Central Avenue to the W of and along Underwood Avenue to Shake-N-Burger property.

6. Trail shall run S from Shake-N-Burger property across Lake Street; thence W along the N side of the Montello Municipal Building at Lake/Underwood Avenue into the W area of the Montello Municipal Parking Lot.

7. Snowmobile parking shall be permitted in the parking area S of the Montello Municipal Building only by gaining access from the W parking lot.

8. From the N/W area of the Montello Municipal Parking Lot trail shall run either direction; in a westerly direction on the parking lot drive to the Montello Marina; thence S on Sunset Drive known as Dredge Bank Road. Trail shall continue on Sunset Drive in an easterly direction to Hwy. 22S.

9. Trail shall continue S from Sunset Drive along either side of Hwy. 22S across the Fox River Bridges to Water Street.

10. Trail shall run in either direction, E/W on N and S sides of Water Street from Hwy. 22S intersection to City Boundaries.

11. In addition there shall be a southerly trail from W Water Street on a private drive known as Lakeside Bar Drive S to CTH "K".

12. In either direction E/W from Central Avenue; in an easterly direction trail shall run across Underwood Avenue to Park Street.

A. Continuing E on either side of Park Street E to Douglas Avenue.

B. From Park Street N on either side of Douglas Avenue to the northern end of the Montello Granite Company property; thence in an easterly direction.

C. Trail shall run E/W; in an easterly direction to a point on the Montello Public School property NW of the Athletic

(2) Additional Rules.
(a) Speed. No person shall operate a snowmobile at a rate of speed exceeding 10 miles per hour within the City of Montello.
(b) Hours of Operation. No person shall operate a snowmobile within the City of Montello between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday or between 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Sunday through Friday.

(c) Snowmobile parking will be prohibited in the Parking Lot on the South side of the Municipal Building. Snowmobiles will be allowed to park in the area of the Montello Marina on the north side of the building. The parking area will be posted by signs.

(d) Parking will be permitted from 6:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday and from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Sunday through Friday in a designated area on the paved portion near the SW corner of the Municipal Building. The Snowmobile Club will post signs stating the Hours of Parking, Hours of Operation and the Speed Limit, at both of the designated Parking Areas.

(3) Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

(a) All ordinances regulating snowmobile trails upon the streets, roads and highways within the City of Montello, Wisconsin, and all conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances heretofore enacted by the City Council of the City of Montello are hereby repealed.

(4) Severability. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Common Council would have passed the other provisions,

sections, subsections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to the other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

(5) Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
